Pre-requisites

Please review the following prerequisites and ensure they are met prior to installation;

IMPORTANT NOTE

**MEDTECH (ANY VERSION) MUST BE INSTALLED ON THE SYSTEM.
THE NPCC DATA EXTRACTION TOOL MUST BE INSTALLED.**

- **The MedTech32 database must be backed up.**
- **The update must be installed on the MedTech32 Server machine and all users must be logged out of MedTech.**
- **Ensure that the database that was last logged onto on the Server machine is the database that requires the update. If unsure, run MedTech32, login to the required database from the Server and then log out and close Medtech32 prior to running this update.**

Introduction

This update installs a new script file for the NPCC Data Extraction Tool.

Installation

1. Ensure that you are running MedTech32 (any version).
2. Ensure that the NPCC Data Extraction Tool has been installed.
3. Visit our website at www.medtechglobal.com. Click the link to the **Australia** website (located at the top of the window) and click on **Downloads, Useful Tools and Documents**.
4. Here you will find the **MedTech NPCC Extraction Tool – Script Update**.
5. In the **File Download Security Warning** dialogue box select **Run** (as indicated below).
6. In the **Open File Security Warning** dialogue box select the **Run** option.
7. The update will then begin to install.
8. Once the installation has completed successfully a confirmation message will be displayed. Click on **OK**.

Issues Addressed in the Update

It has been identified that the current script file for the extraction utility is allowing for inactive records to be exported. This update will install an updated script file to ensure that inactive records are not counted.
