Installation Prerequisites

Please review the following prerequisites and ensure they are met prior to installation;

IMPORTANT: This documentation contains valuable information that, if not read, could seriously affect the upgrade progress and/or possible down time of your network.

1. Your practice **MUST** be on **Medtech32 Version 19.5 or above**. If you **ARE NOT** on Medtech32 Version 19.5 or above, please **DO NOT** continue.
2. Ensure **ALL** users (including remote users) have logged out of Medtech32 and **ALL** scheduled utilities, backup or maintenance tasks that require access to the databases have been stopped.
3. Please ensure the Medtech32 Scheduler, NIR Directory Monitoring Utility, ACC Directory Monitor, Clinical Audit Tool Action Monitor and ManageMyHealth Online Appointments Manager are shut down prior to running the update.
4. Ensure the person(s) who will be performing the upgrade have read through all of the release documentation and installation instructions.
5. Ensure you are logged onto Windows with Administrative rights when performing **ANY** installation, update, or maintenance tasks.
6. This update **MUST** be run on the Medtech32 Server and all users must be logged out of Medtech32.
7. This update must also be run on any laptop that is used for Briefcasing.

Medtech 32 Update Installation

1. Ensure that you are running **Version 19.5** or above of Medtech32. This can be checked by logging into Medtech32 and selecting **Help ► About Medtech32** (see pre requisites above).
 2. Visit our website at www.medtechglobal.com.
 3. Select "New Zealand" in the region drop down (top right hand side of the window).
 4. Select menu, **Medtech Online ► Medtech32 ► Downloads**. The New Zealand Medtech32 Updates page will be displayed.
 5. Here you will find the **Version 19.7 Build 3128 Beating the Blues Update (March 2011)**.
 6. In the **File Download Security Warning** dialogue box, select **Run**.
 7. In the **Open File Security Warning Dialogue** box, select **Run** option.
1. The installation screen will appear.



2. The installation process will begin.
3. Once the update is completed, the following message will be displayed.

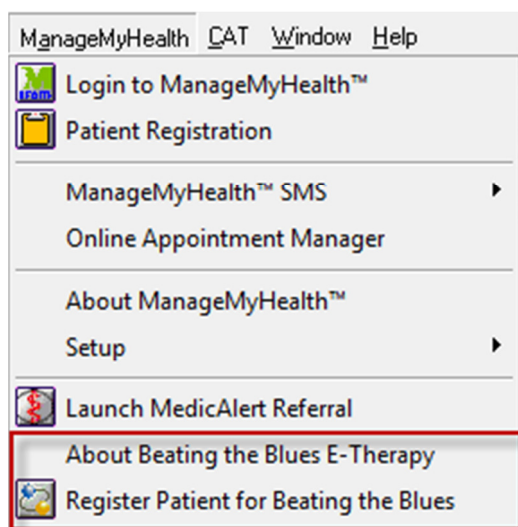


Beating the Blues

Functionality of Beating the Blues Menu Items

About Beating the Blues E-Therapy

When selected, this menu item will launch the New Zealand Beating the Blues website <http://www.beatingtheblues.co.nz/>

Register Patient for Beating the Blues

When selected, this menu item will launch the Beating the Blues Registration Form to enable the provider to register the selected patient for the Beating the Blues programme.

Activation of Beating the Blues Menu Items

The Beating the Blues menu items will be enabled and disabled based on the following criteria:

About Beating the Blues

The menu item About Beating the Blues E-Therapy will be enabled all the time regardless of a patient being active on the palette or not.

Register Patient for Beating the Blues

The menu item Register Patient for Beating the Blues will be enabled only when there is a patient active on the palette in the Medtech32 application.

The menu item Register Patient for Beating the Blues will be disabled when there is NO patient active on the palette in the Medtech32 application.

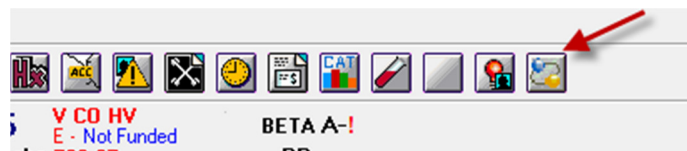
Beating the Blues Toolbar Button

An icon for Beating the Blues will be available in the Medtech Toolbar setup to enable the user to select to Register a Patient for Beating the Blues through an icon rather than navigating the menu.



Select the Register Patient for Beating the Blues Icon and move it from the Un Selected to Selected side of the Toolbar setup for the user.

Once completed the icon will be available and active on the Toolbar when any patient is selected.



When clicking on the Register Patient for Beating the Blues icon on the Toolbar, this will launch the Beating the Blues Registration Form to enable the provider to register the selected patient for the Beating the Blues programme.
